No Salary for Staff of Nirmala Senior Secondary School Since April 2021

The teaching and nonteaching staff of Nirmala Senior Secondary School have been working without salary since April 2021. Nirmala Senior Secondary School is a Government Aided school and it is being reported that the salary of the staff of the school has not been paid because the Education Department is not releasing the funds of the aid extended to the school.

The staff are reportedly in distress because of not receiving salary for a long

period. Earlier Nicobar Times had reported how the staff of Muslim Education Society School (MES School) were in distress because of not receiving their salary for a long period.

Sources have informed that the staff of MES School, Azad Nagar have still not received their salary.

Both Nirmala Senior

Secondary School and MES School are Govt. Aided Minority Educational Institutions. The nonpayment of salary to the staffs of both the schools is becoming a serious issue as it is drastically affecting the lives of the staff. The staff are continuing with their work even after not receiving the salary for such a long period. The staff of Nirmala Senior Secondary School have started tweeting their problems to the authorities under #savethesoulsofnirmala.

The staff of Education Department including the teaching and non-teaching staff are paid their salaries on time every month, whereas the staff of Govt. Aided schools do not receive their salaries for months. During the COVID-19 pandemic, the Education Department released advisories and instructions to Private Schools asking them to pay regular salaries to their teachers, but here in the case of these Govt. Aided schools the same department is reportedly holding out the aid through which teachers and other staff of the school are paid their salaries.

It is difficult to understand why the salaries of these staff who are suffering since long cannot be released by the Education Department. These staffs have families, some of them are sole bread earners and they are in distress because they have not been paid for more

than six months.

The intention of the Education Department is unclear as they have not replied to an email sent by Nicobar Times asking for the reason for the non-payment of salaries to the staff of MES School, Azad Nagar.

Whatever the reason, Education Department

should immediately release the salaries of the staff of both the Govt. Aided Schools, so that they can clear their dues and take care of the needs of their families.

Vishal Jolly Requests Joint Survey and Sanction of **Compensation for Diglipur Flood Victims**

> VISHAL JOLLY REQUESTS JOINT SURVEY AND SANCTION OF **COMPENSATION FOR** DIGLIPUR FLOOD VICTIMS

Mr. Vishal Jolly, National Executive Member, Bharatiya Janata Party, Former State President, BIP, A&N Islands & Member, Home Ministry Advisory Committee has urged the Administration to conduct a joint survey to assess the extent of damage caused by the flood in Diglipur. Mr. Vishal Jolly was on a visit to North and Middle Andaman recently. During his visit, Mr. Vishal Jolly visited the flood-affected areas of Diglipur. He particularly visited Subhash Gram, R K Gram, Nabagram,

Sitanagar, D B Gram and Madhupur to assess the situation.

In his letter to the Chief Secretary, Mr. Jolly mentioned that a severe flood has caused significant loss to the property of the residents. He added that houses, ration articles, agriculture produce, livestock, electronic appliances, fishery farm and crops have been damaged causing huge financial loss to the residents. He added that islanders are already reeling under the pandemic and at the same time the flood has caused heavy

damage to their properties and those affected are seeking adequate compensation from the Administration for their losses.

Mr. Jolly mentioned that he visited the flood-affected areas, held discussions with those affected and as per his assessment the impact of the flood on the residents is severe. Mr. Vishal Jolly mentioned that the damage is required to be ascertained by deputing a Joint Survey team comprising of members from the Agriculture Department, Animal Husbandry Department,

Fisheries Department and Revenue Department. He added that the move of the administration to conduct the ongoing survey to grant compensation/relief is a welcome step.

Mr. Vishal Jolly concluded by requesting that a separate Joint Survey team comprising of members from the Agriculture Department, Animal Husbandry Department, Fisheries Department and Revenue Department should be deputed to assess the damage caused by the flood and appropriate

relief/compensation should be sanctioned to those affected by the flood as soon as possible.
