

The Free Press Journal recently reported that an exercise is underway by the Govt. of India to hand over the charge of the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands to Mr. Praful Patel, the administrator of the Union Territories of Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu as well as Lakshadweep.

Mr. Praful Patel is a former politician of the Bharatiya Janata Party from Gujarat and has served as the MoS Home Minister of Gujarat

Nirmala School Staff Stage After School Protest to Demand Payment of their Salaries

Nicobar Times had earlier reported that the staff of Nirmala Senior Secondary School have not received their salaries since April 2021. The members of the staff are facing a lot of difficulties because they are not being paid their legitimate remuneration since a long time.

The staff of the school have now started a protest after school hours to press for the payment of their pending salaries. Earlier on Saturday, the staff staged a symbolic protest by dressing in black clothes.

Nicobar Times spoke to the protesting staff and they informed that they have decided to stage a protest every day after school hours and if their demand of payment of their salaries is not met soon, they will also resort to boycotting the school hours.

The staff of the school are in distress since a long time because of non-payment of their salaries and they have reportedly approached the authorities multiple times but their salaries were not released even after assurances.

Sources have informed Nicobar Times that the

delay in payment of salaries to the staff of Nirmala Senior Secondary School is due to non-disbursal of the grant to the school management by the Education Department of Andaman and Nicobar Administration.

Nirmala Senior Secondary School is a Govt. Aided minority institution and it depends on the aid given by Andaman and Nicobar Administration to pay the salary of its staff. There are two Govt. Aided minority institutions in Andaman and Nicobar Islands, the other one being the MES School located at Azad Nagar in South Andaman.

It is being reported the staff of MES School, Azad Nagar are also facing similar problems and had earlier resorted to protest after school hours to press for the payment of their salaries.

The reason for not releasing the grant to these schools by Andaman and Nicobar Administration is not clear as the Education Department has not responded to an email sent to them earlier asking for the reason for the non-payment of salaries to the staff of MES School, Azad Nagar.

The staff of Nirmala School are tweeting the problems being faced by them to the authorities under #savethesoulsofnirmala.



MP Demands Withdrawal of 7 Day Quarantine Rule for those Travelling to Great Nicobar

Mr. Kuldeep Rai Sharma, Member of Parliament, Andaman and Nicobar Islands today requested the Chief Secretary of Andaman and Nicobar Administration to withdraw the seven-day quarantine rule for those travelling to Great Nicobar Island. He also requested the Chief Secretary to schedule a passenger ship with cargo or a cargo ship for Great Nicobar Island as soon as possible to transport the essential commodities to the Island.

In a letter addressed to the Chief Secretary, A & N Administration the Member of Parliament mentioned that he has been informed by the residents of Great Nicobar Island that at present the District Administration of Nicobar District has mandated the seven-day long quarantine rule for all incoming passengers, while in all the other places of this Union Territory the seven-day quarantine system has already been withdrawn.

Member of Parliament in his letter had further mentioned that at present almost 100 per cent of

Islanders have received their first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and a large number of people have also received their second doses of COVID-19 vaccine. He added that considering the vaccination status of the Islands, the period of quarantine has been reduced or withdrawn in all other Islands but for unknown reasons, people are being quarantined for 7 days in Great Nicobar. He mentioned that the 7-day quarantine for incoming passengers at Great Nicobar is causing unnecessary problems for the residents and it is also reducing the overall

efficiency of the Govt. Departments.

MP also informed that at present there is a shortage of potatoes, onions, tomatoes and eggs in Great Nicobar due to the delay in the transfer of cargo from Port Blair to Campbell Bay.

MP requested the Chief Secretary to remove the requirement of 7-day quarantine for the incoming passengers at Great Nicobar and he also requested the Chief Secretary to schedule a ship with cargo for the Island.

Mr. Selvam informed Nicobar Times that he has lodged a Police Complaint against the Patwari and added that the Patwari humiliated him in-front of others at the Jetty.

Mr. Selvam has demanded stringent action against the Patwari as per the law and said that the act of Patwari is a great insult to the entire teacher's community.
