

Ajoy Bairagi Bats for Regular Inter-Island Transportation

Mr. Ajoy Bairagi, State President, Bharatiya Janata Party, Andaman and Nicobar Islands wrote a letter to the Secretary (Shipping), Andaman and Nicobar Administration and to the Deputy Commissioner (South Andaman) requesting them schedule regular to Boats for Ships/Speed Inter-Island for the convenience of the general public.

Mr. Ajoy Bairagi in his letter has informed the officials that due to the geography of the Islands, the general public depends on ships and speed boats for their transportation needs. Mr. Ajoy Bairagi added that due to the current pandemic the modes of transportation in the Islands have been severely affected.

Mr. Bairagi in his letter listed some of the problems being faced by the general public because of the reduced frequency of ships and speed boats.

He informed the officials that most of the major colleges are at Port Blair for which students have to travel from Inter-Islands to Port Blair. He also mentioned that patients and their attenders from Inter-Islands needs to visit G.B Panth Hospital, Port Blair and other major facilities at Port Blair for their treatment.

Mr. Bairagi further mentioned that helicopters services are also available but the services are costly and have limited seats.

Mr. Bairagi also informed the officials that the far-flung Islands depends on Port Blair for all their needs, he added that most of the goods are transported through ships.

He requested the officials to look into the issue and do the needful by scheduling ships and boats for Inter-Islands on a regular basis as operated during the pre-pandemic period by following all SOPs of COVID-19.

He also informed the officials that the general public is frustrated by the

problems they are facing because of the unavailability of transportation and may resort to agitation if the problems are not sorted out at the earliest.

Mr. Kuldeep Rai Sharma, Member of Parliament, Andaman and Nicobar Islands with the intent of health spreading awareness and promoting wellness among the women is organising weeklong health camps with the support of Andaman Nicobar Islands Institute of Medical Sciences (ANIIMS) and private hospitals like Pillar Hospital, Agrawal Eye Hospital & Arun Hospital at various locations in South Andaman District.

The week-long Health Camps for the women started off with the inaugural camp organised at Wandoor Community Hall on 01.10.2021. The camp was inaugurated by the Member of Parliament in the presence of doctors of ANIIMS belonging to various disciplines led by Dr. Padi.

He further mentioned that such health camps helps in the early diagnosis of diseases or illnesses and early diagnosis makes it easier for the disease to be treated, increases the chances of reversing the damage.

Mr. Kuldeep Rai Sharma informed that on 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th & 7th of October 2021, the Health Camps for women will be organised at

The Directorate of Civil Aviation, Andaman and Nicobar Administration has decided to increase the frequency of helicopter services to various Islands w.e.f 4th of October 2021.

The new schedule will have 04 weekly services for Campbell Bay, 03 weekly services for Kamorta, Katchal and Teressa, 01 weekly flight for Chowra, 09 Flights for Car Nicobar every week.

There will be 05 flights every week for Mayabunder, 04 flights every week for Diglipur and 01 flight every week for Rangat.

There will be 03 flights every week for Hutbay.

Residents of remote Islands had been demanding an increase in helicopter services for a long time and this decision of the Directorate of Civil Aviation will bring them some relief.
