Immediate Resumption of Free Air Travel for Referred Patients from Remote Islands to Sri Vijaya Puram Needed

Indian Army to Hold Recruitment Rally in Andaman & Nicobar Islands from November 26-30

The Indian Army's Recruiting (Headquarters), Office Chennai, is set to conduct recruitment rally at Netaii Stadium in Sri Vijaya Puram, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, from November 26 to 30, 2024. This rally aims to enroll candidates shortlisted through the online Common Entrance Exam for various positions, including Agniveer General Duty (All Arms), Agniveer Technical (All Arms), Agniveer Tradesman 10th Pass (All Arms), Agniveer Tradesman 8th Pass (House Keeper & Mess Keeper), Soldier Technical Nursing Assistant/ Assistant Nursing (Veterinary), and Agniveer (General Duty) Women for the Corps of Military Police.

Candidates are required to bring all specified documents as listed in the rally notification available on the official website, http:// www.joinindianarmy.nic.in. The correct format for each document, including affidavits, is also provided in the notification. Those who arrive at the rally site with

incomplete or improperly formatted documents will not be permitted to participate.

The eligible candidates for this rally are those who have registered and have been shortlisted from the Union of Andaman & Territory Nicobar Islands, including Nicobar, North & Middle Andaman, and South Andaman. Admit cards with reporting details, including date and time, will be issued on candidates' registered email IDs. It is advised that candidates frequently check both the website and their email for updates. The discontinuation of free air travel for patients from remote islands to Sri Vijaya Puram has caused significant hardship for the local population, particularly those in urgent need of medical care. This change has placed an immense burden on islanders and non-islanders alike, especially from low-income those backgrounds who struggle to afford the steep helicopter fares required for medical travel.

Residents of the Nicobar Group of Islands are facing a particularly dire situation, as the cost of helicopter travel is the highest due to the vast distances involved. For instance, the fare from Great Nicobar or Nancowry to Sri Vijaya Puram is prohibitively expensive, leaving many in these remote areas with limited options for timely medical intervention.

Previously, the administration covered the full cost of air travel for patients referred to Sri Vijaya

Puram by a doctor, along with one attendant. This critical service allowed patients in need of emergency surgeries or specialised care to reach Sri Vijaya Puram without incurring any costs. However, over time, the administration gradually reduced this support, first limiting free travel to patients alone and requiring attendants to pay their own way. Eventually, free air travel was restricted to tribal patients only, and now, even that provision has been entirely withdrawn.

Currently, the helicopter fare from Campbell Bay to Sri Vijaya Puram stands at 5,350 for islanders and a staggering 13,400 for nonislanders. Similarly, the fare from Kamorta to Sri Vijaya Puram is

4,350 for islanders and 10,800 for non-islanders. These costs are far beyond the reach of many families, especially those from lower-income groups. As a result, patients often delay essential travel to Sri Vijaya Puram, despite doctors' recommendations, simply because they cannot afford the fare.

The termination of this once-

lifesaving service has sparked widespread outrage among the public and political leaders alike, who have repeatedly called for the reinstatement of free air travel for referred patients. Their pleas, however, have so far not yielded any result.

For the people of these remote islands, air travel is not a luxuryit is a necessity. Specialized medical care is unavailable in these regions, leaving patients with no choice but to travel to Sri Vijava Puram for surgeries and advanced treatments. The administration's decision to end this vital service has left many residents in a precarious position, unable to access the care they desperately need

While the administration deserves credit for facilitating emergency evacuations when regular air travel is unavailable, its decision to withdraw free travel for patients from remote islands has drawn sharp criticism. The suffering endured by these families is difficult to quantify, but it is a stark reality that continues to worsen as the policy remains in place.

Public Advisory: Beware of Fake Stock Market Investment Websites and Apps

surge in fraudulent stock market investment websites and applications that are deceiving unsuspecting investors through social media platforms like Facebook, Instagram, and Google, These scams are being promoted through sponsored advertisements

videos of well-known individuals to appear legitimate. Users are then redirected to fake WhatsApp and Telegram groups operated by cybercriminals posing as trading groups, financial advisors, or investment platforms.

featuring manipulated images and Once added to these groups, victims are exposed to deceptive stock tips, live classes, and promises of exclusive access to lucrative investment opportunities. Fraudsters also share links to fake trading apps on the Play Store, App Store, or directly share APK

files. They provide Indian bank accounts-often belonging to deposits. mules"—for "money Although initial small payouts are made to build trust. communication ceases after substantial amounts are deposited, resulting in victims losing their investments to these cvber scams

Advisory for Public Safety Against Stock Market Scams

Exercise caution with sponsored ads on Facebook, Instagram, or Google that promote investment groups on WhatsApp or Telegram, as many may be fraudulent.

Be vigilant against impersonators claiming to represent FIIs, FPOs, financial advisors, or reputable institutions.

Avoid sharing sensitive financial details, such as bank information or login credentials, with unknown sources.

- Remain skeptical of investment offers that promise unrealistically high returns

Rising Threat of Illegal Digital Lending Apps: Stay Vigilant and Seek Police Assistance if Needed

short-term loans and microcredits at interest rates. These apps, often platforms charge hidden fees operating outside the purview of and the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), target low-income individuals, compelling them to provide aspect is the demand for access access to sensitive personal to private information such as

vulnerable groups by offering data in exchange for loans.

exorbitant Many of these digital lending processing charges. trapping borrowers in a cycle of debt. The most concerning contact lists, location data, and media files like photos and videos. Once obtained, this data is often misused for blackmail and harassment, with some threats and victims facing intimidation.

These illegal apps heavily rely institutions

on bulk SMS campaigns, digital advertisements, chat messengers, and mobile app stores to lure unsuspecting borrowers on a large scale. With such deceptive practices becoming increasingly common, authorities have issued a strong advisory, urging citizens to avoid engaging with these platforms.

Authorities have emphasized that any individual who has fallen prey to blackmail, harassment, or fraud as a result of using these apps should report the incident immediately to the Cyber Cell in Sri Vijaya Puram, or the nearest police station. Timely reporting could help prevent further exploitation.
