## **36-Year-Old Woman Brutally Murdered in Brichgunj**

#### Nisha Rani Murder Case: **Suspects Absconding, Viral Social Media Posts With Suspects' Photographs and CCTV Video Urge Public to Inform Police**

In the ongoing investigation into the Nisha Rani murder case, photographs of four suspects identified by the police have gone viral, with social media posts urging the public to assist in their capture. According to information received from sources late night on 22nd December 2024, the suspects were still absconding. These viral posts urge citizens to immediately inform law enforcement if the suspects are spotted. Nisha Rani, a resident of Brichgunj, was tragically murdered on 21st December 2024 at Brichgunj area of Sri Vijaya Puram, sparking widespread concern across the community.

Sources reveal that suspects are not locals, but are believed to have traveled to the Andaman and Nicobar Islands from mainland India. It has been confirmed that the four individuals checked into a hotel in Dairy Farm a day before the murder, but have not been seen near the hotel since the incident.

One widely circulated message accompanying the suspects' photographs states:

"WANTED ALERT A&N Police seeks information on four suspects involved in a murder

registered case 21/12/2024. Pahargaon on Suspects' Details: Age Group: 25-30 years; Native State: Tamil Nadu; Language: Primarily Tamil you have regarding these information individuals, please contact us immediately at: 9531888000, 9531801107."

Additionally, a CCTV video showing the suspects entering Hotel Shalini in Dairy Farm has also been widely shared. The accompanying message reads: "In this video, you can see the four accused in the PS Pahargaon murder case who stayed at Hotel Shalini, Dairy Farm. Their faces are clearly visible. Citizens are advised to remain vigilant and share any information with the police. Do not attempt to apprehend or confront them alone, as they are considered dangerous. For assistance. contact 03192-250525/112/100. Stay safe.'

The origin of these messages remains unclear, but the contact numbers listed are confirmed to belong to police officers, the Pahargaon Police Station, and emergency helplines. Citizens should assist law enforcement by providing any information that could help in tracking the suspects.

Citizens are urged to stay alert and immediately report any relevant information to



## Hindu Rashtra Shakti Requests Increased Traffic Police Deployment for New Year Celebrations

In light of the upcoming New Year celebrations, the State Youth President of Hindu Rashtra Shakti,

Angshuman Roy, has submitted a request to the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Andaman and Nicobar Islands, urging the deployment of additional traffic police forces across key areas in Sri Vijaya Puram. The request comes amid concerns about public safety during the festive

season, particularly regarding the increase in liquor consumption and subsequent rash driving.

Roy highlighted that many local hotels and resorts are advertising unlimited liquor offers, which could lead to an uptick in reckless driving, especially among the youth. He expressed concern over the potential dangers posed by speeding and erratic behaviour, particularly at night around popular spots like Marina Park and the National Highway. Roy emphasised that public safety, especially that of women, should be

prioritised, noting that celebrations should not come at the cost of a family's well-being.


To mitigate the risks, the Hindu Shakti has urged the administration to deploy additional police personnel equipped devices alcohol detection (Alcometers) to ensure that drunk driving violations are properly enforced. Roy specifically requested enhanced patrolling in high-traffic areas such as Delanipur Junction, Junction, Prothrapur Lighthouse Junction, Dollygunj Junction, DBRAIT Gate, and others, especially after 10

Furthermore, Roy pointed out the importance of monitoring routes leading to popular tourist spots, such as Corbyn's Cove Beach, Chouldari, Wandoor, and the coastal areas near Dignabad and Haddo, where rash driving may pose a significant risk.

In his letter, Roy made it clear that if any accidents occur due to reckless driving or alcohol consumption, responsibility should be attributed to the concerned traffic police teams who fail to act.

The objective of the request, Roy noted, is to ensure that the people of the islands can celebrate the New Year in a safe and responsible manner, fostering an atmosphere of joy without compromising public safety.

Roy has also forwarded the copies of his email to Chief Secretary, DGP, and Deputy Commissioner (SA) for further action, as well as to local print media for wider awareness.
