



Workshop Addition Fisheries Islands on Tuna Held to Sector in Value Boost A&N





The Department of Fisheries, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, in collaboration with the National Institute of Fisheries Post Harvest Technology and Training (NIFPHATT), Cochin, organized a workshop on 'Tuna Value Addition' on March 28, 2025. Sponsored by the National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB), Hyderabad, the event was conducted at the conference hall of the Department of Industries as part of the Government of India's 'Tuna Cluster Development in A&N Islands' initiative. Around 75 stakeholders, including fishermen, fisheries cooperatives, selfhelp group (SHG) members, and beneficiaries of the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY), participated in the workshop.

Ms. Jyoti Kumari, IAS, Secretary (Fisheries), graced the inaugural session as the chief guest. In her address, she commended the Department of Fisheries for facilitating the involvement of NIFPHATT, Cochin—India's leading institute in fisheries post-harvest technology—for conducting this specialized workshop in the Islands. She expressed confidence that the workshop's outcomes would significantly contribute to the development of the Tuna Cluster in A&N Islands. Encouraging the participants to engage actively in

the sessions, she urged them to adopt the acquired skills in their fishing and post-harvest practices.

During the event, Secretary (Fisheries) released a booklet prepared by the Department of Fisheries titled 'Potential and Possibilities of Tuna Value Addition in A&N Islands'.

Dr. Eaknath B. Chakurkar, Director, ICAR-CIARI, Sri Vijaya Puram, assured full support from the Fisheries Science Division of ICAR-CIARI in developing a comprehensive plan for Tuna Cluster Development in the region.

Earlier, Ms. Jagtap Kalyani Rajendra, Director of Fisheries, welcomed the gathering and highlighted the department's training and extension activities, along with recent initiatives aimed at upgrading skills in tuna fishing and post-harvest utilization. Mr. B. Balanayak, Mechanical Marine Engineer, Fishery Survey of India, and Mr. S. U. Maheshwar Rao, Governing Body Member of NFDB, also addressed the audience. The inaugural session concluded with a vote of thanks proposed by Dr. K. Gopal, Joint Director.

The workshop featured technical and practical sessions by industry experts, including Mr. Chittaranjan Raul, Scientist, ICAR-CIARI; Dr. C. Babu, Fisheries Scientist, FSI; Mr. K. Kamalraj, Processing Technologist; Dr. Nithin C. T., PQAS, NIFPHATT, Kochi; and Mr. Praphul Dev D., Assistant Manager, NABARD. These sessions covered various aspects of tuna fishing, post-harvest management, value addition, marketing, and export.

An interactive session with entrepreneurs and SHG members was also conducted to assess stakeholders' requirements for improving tuna fishing and value addition in the Islands. Additionally, an exhibition stall was set up to showcase various fish value-added products developed by NIFPHATT, Cochin, with the aim of familiarizing participants with innovative seafood products.

The workshop concluded on a positive note, with participants expressing enthusiasm for adopting new techniques and contributing to the growth of the tuna value addition sector in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. (Story Based on PR)

SMART PDS System Migration to MeghRaj Cloud: Ration Distribution to be Affected from March 31 to April 4





Ration card beneficiaries and Fair Price Shop (FPS) owners are informed that the migration of the SMART PDS system from NDC Shastry Park to MeghRaj Cloud is scheduled to commence on March 31, 2025.

The migration process, which involves DNS remapping and system testing, is expected to take approximately 3 to 4 days for completion. During this period, access to the ePOS web portals and related web services will remain temporarily unavailable.

As a result, ration distribution will be suspended from March 31 to April 4, 2025. Beneficiaries are advised to plan accordingly and collect their essential supplies in advance to avoid inconvenience.

Normal operations are expected to resume immediately after the migration is successfully completed. (Story Based on PR)

DIC to Organize Awareness Programmes on PMEGP at Swaraj Dweep

The District Industries Centre (DIC), under the Department of Industries, is set to organize a series of 'Awareness-cum-Motivational Programmes' on the Prime Minister Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) and other government-sponsored schemes. These programmes aim to educate and motivate unemployed youth to take up self-employment ventures by availing benefits under various schemes.

The programmes will be conducted in collaboration with Gram Panchayats, the Departments of Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, and Fisheries, as well as the State Bank of India (SBI), Andaman & Nicobar State Cooperative Bank (ANSCB), and local NGOs. The sessions will begin in the first week of April 2025 and will be held across different parts of Swaraj Dweep.

The primary goal of these programmes is to inform and empower unemployed youth by providing detailed insights into the opportunities available through schemes such as PMEGP. The sessions will also include hands-on guidance to aspiring entrepreneurs on how to submit applications, ensuring that they are equipped to

apply for financial assistance effectively.

Filled-in applications, complete with the necessary documentation, will be collected on the spot and uploaded to the PMEGP online portal. After verification and scrutiny, these applications will be forwarded to the respective banks opted by the applicants for financial support under the PMEGP scheme.

Unemployed youth from Swaraj Dweep interested in establishing self-employment ventures in the manufacturing, service, or trading sectors through the PMEGP scheme are encouraged to attend the awareness sessions. Participants are requested to bring the following documents: 1. Aadhaar Card 2. One passport-size photograph 3. Local Certificate 4. Category Certificate (if applicable) 5. Educational Qualification Certificate.

Congress Chief Urges Urgent Intervention to Improve Conditions in Female Ward at GB Pant Hospital





The Andaman & Nicobar Territorial Congress Committee President, Mr. Rangalal Halder, has formally requested the Directorate of Health Services, A&N Administration, to take immediate steps to improve the deteriorating conditions in Female Ward 2 of GB Pant Hospital.

In his letter, Mr. Halder highlighted the challenges faced by patients in the ward, which accommodates around 30-40 individuals. He pointed out that inadequate ventilation and poor hygiene standards have created an uncomfortable environment, further aggravated by nonfunctional or insufficient fans that prevent proper air circulation.

He also raised concerns about the overall deterioration of the ward due to prolonged neglect and lack of maintenance. "The walls have not been repainted for a long time, and the shortage of sanitation staff has worsened the unhygienic conditions. Only one sweeper is assigned to the entire ward, which is insufficient to maintain the required hygiene standards," Mr. Halder stated.

To address these concerns, Mr. Halder has made three urgent appeals to the Directorate of Health Services:

- 1. Installation of Three Air Conditioners to improve air circulation and comfort.
- 2. Increase in the Number of Sweepers to ensure proper cleanliness.
- 3. Immediate Maintenance Work to restore the ward to acceptable standards.

Emphasizing the importance of providing a safe and comfortable environment for patients, Mr. Halder urged the administration to take swift action and address these pressing issues without delay. (Story Based on PR)

Fishermen Welfare Association Expresses Gratitude for Insurance Premium Subvention Scheme for Fishing Vessels Under PMMSY





The Fishermen Welfare Association of Andaman and Nicobar Islands has extended heartfelt thanks to the Central Government for approving the implementation of an Insurance Premium subvention scheme for fishing vessels and boats (Marine Hull & Machinery) under the Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY).

In a letter addressed to Hon'ble Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi, Union Minister for Fisheries, Animal Husbandry, and Dairying Mr. Rajeev Ranjan Singh (alias Lalan Singh), and other senior officials, the association acknowledged the National Fisheries Development Board (NFDB) for issuing the approval via letter No. NFDB/PMMSY/ Vessel Insurance/ 2024-25 dated March 4, 2025.

The scheme offers a significant insurance premium subvention where the central government covers a major share, reducing the financial burden on fishermen. As a result, the registered 4,027 vessel owners in the Union Territory of Andaman and Nicobar Islands will be able to avail of this beneficiary-oriented scheme, ensuring financial and livelihood security against both foreseen and unforeseen events.

B. Hema Raju, General Secretary of the association, expressed optimism that this initiative would greatly benefit the fishing community in the islands. Copies of the letter were also forwarded to Mr. S.U. Maheswar Rao, Governing Body Member of A&N Islands for the National Fisheries Development Board, and Mr. Janardhan Gangapitra, National Convenor of the Central Fishers Welfare Association, New Delhi.

The association has reiterated its commitment to safeguarding the interests of the fishing community and ensuring they reap maximum benefits from government schemes aimed at their welfare.



Farmers Urged to Contact Electricity Department for Solar Pump Installation Under PM-KUSUM Scheme





The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE) has sanctioned 34 stand-alone solar pumps and 436 individual grid-connected solar pumps under the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Urja Suraksha evam Utthan Mahabhiyan (PM-KUSUM) scheme for the Andaman and Nicobar Islands for the financial year 2024-25. The scheme, launched in March 2019, aims to reduce diesel dependency in the agricultural sector and boost farmers' income by promoting solar energy adoption.

The scheme will be implemented by the Electricity Department of the Andaman and Nicobar Administration, focusing on two key components:

Component B: Stand-alone Solar Pumps:

Under this component, farmers in off-grid areas will receive assistance to install stand-alone solar agricultural pumps or replace existing diesel pumps. Priority will be given to small and marginal farmers, especially those using micro-irrigation systems.

- Pump Capacity: Solar PV capacity in kW will be capped according to the pump capacity in HP, as per MNRE guidelines. For instance, a 3 HP pump

can have a solar capacity of up to 3 kW.

- Financial Assistance: Farmers will receive 50% of the benchmark or tender cost (whichever is lower) as Central Financial Assistance (CFA), with 20% of the cost borne by the farmer through selffinancing or bank loans. Additionally, a 30% subsidy from the Union Territory (UT) Administration is expected to be notified, subject to approval.

Component C: Individual Pump Solarisation (IPS):

This component focuses on solarisation of gridconnected agricultural pumps to ensure reliable day-time solar power for farmers. The initiative aims to incentivize farmers to conserve water by enabling them to sell surplus solar power to the Electricity Department.

- Solar Capacity: Farmers can install solar PV systems with a capacity up to twice that of their pump capacity in kW. This will allow them to meet their irrigation needs while earning additional income from surplus solar power.
- Financial Assistance: Similar to Component B,


50% of the benchmark or tender cost will be provided as CFA. Farmers will contribute 20% of the cost, with the option of self-financing or availing a bank loan. Additionally, a 30% subsidy from the Union Territory (UT) Administration is expected to be notified, subject to approval.
