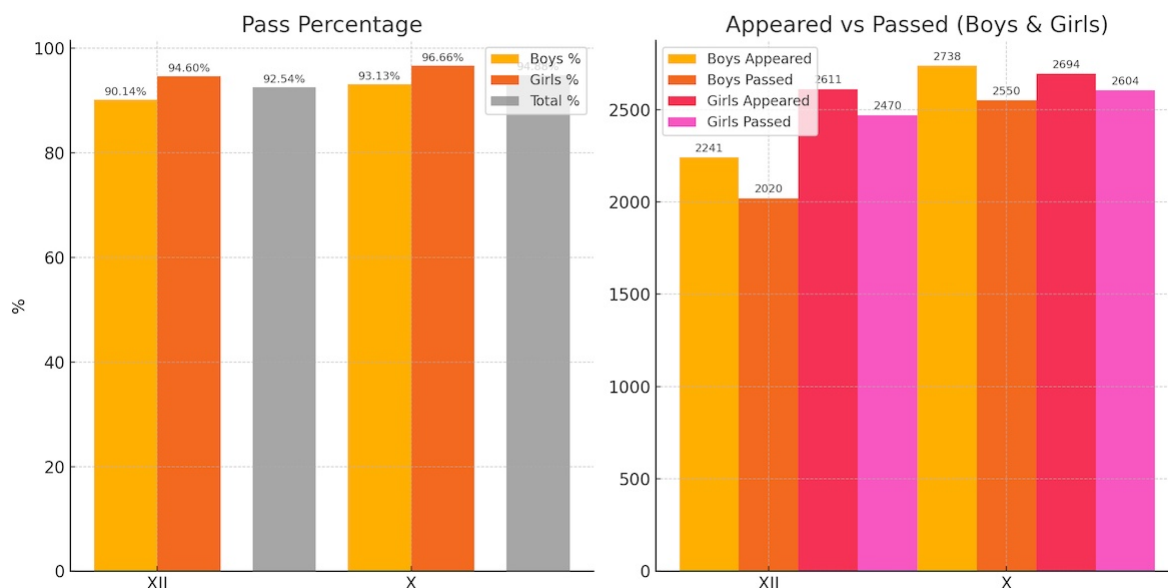

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has announced the results for the All India Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (Class XII) and the All India Secondary School Examination (Class X) for the academic year 2024-25. Students from the Andaman and Nicobar Islands recorded higher overall pass percentages

In Class XII, 4,882 students were registered — 2,257 boys and 2,625 girls. Out of 4,852 who appeared (2,241 boys and 2,611 girls), a total of 4,490 students passed the examination. This included 2,020 boys and 2,470 girls. The overall pass percentage stood at 92.54%, with 94.60% girls and 90.14% boys passing the exam. 25 schools in

In Class X, 5,473 students were registered — 2,763 boys and 2,710 girls. Of the 5,432 who appeared (2,738 boys and 2,694 girls), 5,154 passed — 2,550 boys and 2,604 girls. The overall pass percentage was 94.88%, with 96.66% girls and 93.13% boys passing. A total of 67 schools in the islands secured 100% pass results in Class X.

The results for the All India Secondary School Examination (Class X) for the academic year 2024-25 were declared on 13th May 2025, with a remarkable 67 schools from the Andaman and Nicobar Islands securing a perfect 100% pass rate.

will be chaired by the respective District Deputy Commissioners and will focus on surveying and cataloguing historical records, documents, manuscripts, and photographs related to the Islands' rich

heritage. A meeting of the RRSC was convened on May 13, 2025, at the Mini Conference Hall of the Secretariat under the chairmanship of Secretary (Archives), Ms. Smitha R.,

IAS. The meeting saw active participation from members of all three District Sub-Committees, along with two representatives from the National Archives of India, New Delhi. Valuable suggestions and guidance were shared during the session to advance the preservation efforts.

Ms. Smitha R., who also heads the Archives Department, urged individuals and private institutions possessing relevant historical materials to come forward and share them with the A&N Archives. Contributions can be made either in person or by contacting the Archives office at 230695, or through the respective District Deputy Commissioners.

The Administration has assured that any costs incurred in photocopying or reproducing documents will be borne by the government. Furthermore, all contributors will be duly acknowledged by the RRSC for their support in preserving the Islands' historical legacy, which will be a valuable resource for researchers, students, and the general public.
