## 1.560 Kg Ganja Seized in Anti-Narcotics Operation in South Andaman, One Held







Deputy Superintendent of Police (Narcotics), Mr. Balram, DANIPS, who immediately ordered the formation of a raiding team. proceeded to the location near Shivram Complex with necessary equipment, including a drug detection kit and an electronic weighing scale. he identified himself as Hemant Rao, a resident of Anarkali near the playground in Sri Vijaya Puram. His identity matched the one provided by the informant. The suspect was informed of the police's intent to search him and his parcel, and was made aware of his legal rights. The parcel in question, a white plastic bag, was identified found to contain three rolls of 1.560 kilograms in total. Upon inspection, both packets were found to contain a dry leafy substance. Preliminary tests using a narcotics detection kit confirmed the substance to be ganja. The two packets were weighed in front of witnesses, and was found to be wrapped in brown tape. Following the seizure, Hemant Rao was arrested under Section 20(b)(ii)(B) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. The entire process was documented digitally using the E-Saakshya platform.

Acting on these directives, Inspector Vikas Singh, accompanied by SI Manoj Lal, ASI Sanjay Yadow, HC Laxman Rao, and constables T. Bhavani Shanker, Ratan Das, and M. Raja Rao, Upon reaching the site, the team identified a man matching the informant's description standing near the Andaman Sea Airways office, holding a white plastic parcel. On being questioned,

Facebook from an unknown individual identifying herself as Gambo Muhammed. After accepting the request, the two began chatting regularly and later moved their conversation to WhatsApp. The person subsequently introduced herself as Amelia Mercy Gambo during their chats. In subsequent chats, the woman claimed she intended to travel to India and requested Rs. 22,500 to cover her visa charges. Trusting her, the complainant made the payment via UPI using Google Pay. Later, he received a phone call from an Indian mobile number, where the caller claimed to be an official at Delhi Airport. The caller stated that "Gambo" had arrived in India and was being detained due to excess baggage, for which she was allegedly being asked to pay Rs. 98,000. Believing the situation to be genuine, the complainant transferred additional sums of money in response to various demands. Over a span of about two months he made multiple UPI transactions, ultimately adding up to approximately Rs. 18,00,000/-. Realising that he had been cheated, the victim filed complaints with the National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal, before formally approaching the Cyber Crime Police Station. The case has been registered under Sections 318(4) and 319(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023.

# CIARI Conducts Training on Natural Farming Practices for Nicobari Farmers in Nancowrie



presented the outcomes of the Organic Integrated Farming System (OIFS) developed by CIARI, showcasing successful trials involving vegetables, tubers, spices, fodder, and fruits integrated with goat, pig, poultry, and fish farming.

The training also covered CIARI-developed technologies such as organic waste management and integrated pest and disease control, with a strong emphasis on natural farming techniques and the use of organic inputs to boost soil fertility in tuber-based systems.

A hands-on demonstration was held on the use of the Dweep Leaf Separator, a tool designed to remove the midrib from coconut leaves efficiently. Fifty units of the tool were distributed to women farmers. Additionally, essential agricultural tools and planting materials were distributed to the participants, including 45 crowbars, 40 axes, 30 spades, 500 sweet potato rooted cuttings, and 500 tapioca setts.

A total of 139 farmers from the villages of Kakana, Pilpillow, and Munak actively participated in the programme. The event was coordinated by Dr. Santosh Kumar, Head of KVK Car Nicobar, along with Dr. Abhilash and Mr. Talaviya Harshang Kumar, both Scientists (NRM), under the overall guidance of Dr. E.B. In view of the prevailing and anticipated weather conditions, the sea state is expected to remain rough, with heightened risks for small boats and traditional fishing vessels. Surface wind speeds may hover between 30 to 40 kilometers per hour, gusting up to 50 kilometers per hour, creating unfavourable conditions for marine operations.


