
implementation of "Pink Toilets" across key locations in the islands.

Final Deadline for PHH & AAY e-KYC Update Set for 30th June; Ration Cards to Be Suspended for Non-Compliance

The Department of Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs (CS&CA) has issued a final reminder to all National Food Security Act (NFSA) beneficiaries holding the Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) and Priority Household (PHH) ration

Failure to do so will lead to the suspension of ration cards starting 1st July 2025, rendering beneficiaries ineligible for entitlements under the NFSA. Despite repeated appeals,

beneficiaries have not updated their e-KYC linked with Aadhaar for all members listed on their ration cards. The department has undertaken 260 door-to-door campaigns in remote areas, launched 19 awareness drives through print and electronic media, and leveraged Fair Price Shops to disseminate information. Additionally, phone outreach and the introduction of the 'Mera 1st KYC' mobile app—featuring biometric, iris, and facial recognition—were employed to simplify the process. Still, a significant number of beneficiaries

have yet to complete their e-KYC by visiting Fair Price Shops, the CS&CA Directorate, or designated Supply Units. As per directives from the Government of India, this is the final opportunity for beneficiaries to comply. Beneficiaries are advised to carry Aadhaar numbers of all household members when visiting their nearest Fair Price Shop, the Directorate of CS&CA (Room No. 20, Sri Vijaya Puram), or their respective Supply Units for the e-KYC update. A list of left-out beneficiaries has also been made available at

Fair Price Shops for reference. The department has also highlighted issues faced by child members aged between 5 and 17 years, whose Aadhaar was generated before the age of 5 and thus cannot be used for e-KYC. Such beneficiaries must update their Aadhaar at the nearest Aadhaar Enrolment Centre or approach the CS&CA Directorate for assistance. the Krishi Rath, flagged off from Chouldari village in South Andaman. The Rath travelled extensively through rural and far-flung areas, raising awareness through banners, audio messages, and direct interactions with farmers.

In a special initiative aligned with World Environment Day's 'Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam' campaign, 569 fruit-bearing saplings were planted across Self-Help Group (SHG) locations, Anganwadi Centres, and government offices — symbolizing both environmental consciousness and an emotional connect with nature.

During the fortnight-long drive, 194 events including awareness camps, nukkad natak, sports meets, and chaupals were held, engaging a total of 25,581 participants. The events brought together farmers, fishermen, women from SHGs, and youth. Dedicated efforts by Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs) and departmental officers ensured the campaign reached even the distant Nancowry group of islands, often requiring travel by boat.

Field-level oversight was maintained through regular visits by Deputy Commissioners and Assistant Commissioners. District-level developments were regularly disseminated through press releases, reinforcing the campaign's visibility and impact. Real-time feedback, documentation of best practices, and identification of on-ground challenges were integral components of the campaign.

The successful execution of VKSA in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands has set a benchmark for grassroots agricultural outreach. It reflects the UT Administration's strong commitment to inclusive and sustainable agricultural development in line with the national vision of Viksit Bharat.



Intensive FMD Vaccination Drive Underway in South Andaman; Over 5500 Cattle Vaccinated So Far



to maintain a consistent pace, administering 300–400 vaccinations per day. This performance reflects the Department's strong on-ground coordination and planning. The veterinary teams have been starting work early in the morning and are working closely with Panchayati Raj Institutions to mobilize livestock and reach remote households.

Foot and Mouth Disease is a highly contagious viral illness that affects cattle and other cloven-hoofed animals. While rarely fatal, it causes fever, painful sores in the mouth and feet, lameness, and can lead to a significant decline—up to 30%—in milk production. The economic impact is severe, with FMD-related losses across the country estimated at over 20,000 crore annually. In the Islands, where most dairy farmers are smallholders, the consequences of an outbreak can be devastating.

Vaccination remains the most effective tool in preventing the spread of the disease. The ongoing campaign also supports India's national target of eradicating FMD by 2030. Each vaccinated animal is tagged, and its data is uploaded in real-time to the Bharat Pashudhan Portal, ensuring traceability and integration into a nationwide monitoring system.

The Department has appealed to all livestock owners, especially those with cattle and buffaloes, to cooperate with the visiting teams and ensure their animals are vaccinated during the ongoing round. Their cooperation is essential to protect the health and livelihood of the Island's rural farming community.

The Department of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, Andaman & Nicobar Administration,

has been conducting an intensive Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) vaccination drive across South Andaman since June 2, 2025. As of now, 5,506 cattle have been vaccinated, with the campaign aiming to cover a total of 9,000 cattle by the end of the month.

To minimize stress on the animals, the vaccinations are being administered during the cooler parts of the day. Eleven dedicated veterinary teams are carrying out the drive from various Veterinary Hospitals and Dispensaries, including VH Junglighat, VH

Garacharma (Team I & II), VD Rangachang, VD Manglutan (Team I & II), VD Port Mout, VD Elephant Point, VH Wimberlygunj (Team I & II), and VD Polyclinic.




